Class Descriptions & Prices

Beginner's Tölt / Intermediate Tölt - £10.00 - Riders compete together in groups of 2 or 3, firstly showing slow calm tölt. When the speaker tells them they then return to walk and change the rein and then, for Beginners, show tölt at the speed best for the horse or for Intermediate, show some speed changes. The speaker will direct the riders, and the judges will look for good tölt aids from the rider, a good rhythm from the horse and the way in which the partnership are in harmony, not the highest action or greatest speed. The 6 highest placed riders compete in the final.

Beginner's 4-Gait / Novice 4-Gait (SPONSORED BY) - £10.00

Riders compete together in groups of 2 or 3 on the track. They will show walk, trot, canter and tölt as directed by the speaker. The judges will look for good aids from the rider, a good rhythm from the horse and the way in which the partnership are in harmony, not the highest action or greatest speed. The 6 highest placed riders compete in the final.

Beginners

For Riders not to have won any previous Beginners Tölt classes.

Intermediate

Intermediate tölt for riders and/or horses who don't feel ready for the individual classes, or their horses need further experience on the track (e.g. young horses or horses who lack competition experience)

Intermediate classes are not intended for FIPO standard horse/rider combinations

FIPO F2 (Intermediate 5-Gait) NEW CLASS FOR 2010!! £10.00

Riders compete together in groups of 2 or 3 on the track. They will show walk, trot, canter and tölt as directed by the speaker. They will then show pace individually, 3 times on one long side. The judges will look for good aids from the rider, a good rhythm from the horse and the way in which the partnership are in harmony, not the highest action or greatest speed. The 6 highest placed riders compete in the final.

FIPO Tölt T1 (SPONSORED BY) £15.00 - Riders compete individually, showing one round of working tölt, then change the rein and show one round of tölt with extension on the long sides, followed by one round of fast tölt. The 6 highest placed riders compete in the final. Open to all horse and rider combinations.

FIPO Tölt T2 (SPONSORED BY) £15.00 - Riders compete in groups, showing any speed tölt, followed by slow, calm tölt. They then change rein, and show working to medium tölt with the reins in one hand, and no contact with the horse's mouth. The speaker will tell the riders when to do each part of the test. The 6 highest placed riders compete in the final. Open to all horse and rider combinations.

FIPO 4-Gait (SPONSORED BY) £15.00 - Riders compete individually, showing half a round of walk, one round of working tölt, one round of extended tölt, one round of trot and one round of canter (in any order). The 6 highest placed riders compete in the final. Open to all horse and rider combinations.

FIPO 5-Gait (SPONSORED BY) £15.00 - Riders compete individually, showing half a round of walk, one round of working tölt, one round of trot, one round of canter and one round showing pace on the long sides (so pace is shown twice). The 6 highest placed riders compete in the final. Open to all horse and rider combinations.

Lead Rein (SPONSORED BY) £5.00 - Riders under the age of 10. They will show walk and one faster gait (tölt or trot) as directed by the speaker. They will be expected to show some steering ability by weaving between

some objects (e.g cones), and to stop and start the horse on command between some poles. (must wear hard hats and suitable footwear).

Each horse/rider combination can enter only ONE tolt class and ONE gaits class (not including the lead rein or the beer tolt)
